01 Agricultural Training and Capacity-Building

Practical workshops, learning sessions, and field-oriented educational activities designed for farmers, producer groups, facilitators, community leaders, and agricultural support organizations seeking to strengthen technical knowledge and operational capacity.

02 Applied Agronomy and Crop-Production Support

Training and technical guidance related to soil health, crop management, production practices, crop diversification, sustainable resource use, and practical decision-making across varied farming systems.

03 Climate-Smart and Resilient Agriculture

Education focused on agricultural resilience, risk awareness, resource management, and practical farming approaches adapted to environmental, climatic, and production challenges.

04 Agricultural Entrepreneurship and Farm Management

Practical learning related to agricultural entrepreneurship, farm planning, basic management, recordkeeping, producer organization, market awareness, and informed operational and financial decision-making.

05 Bilingual Outreach, Curriculum Development, and Train-the-Trainer Support

Development and adaptation of accessible bilingual materials, facilitator guides, training modules, workshop tools, and train-the-trainer activities for multilingual agricultural audiences and community-based learning settings.

06 Technical Assistance, MEAL, Documentation, and Implementation Support

Field-informed technical assistance, small-group consultations, monitoring, evaluation, accountability, learning, documentation, planning tools, and implementation support adapted to farmers, producer groups, and agricultural organizations.

The AgriLead Bilingual Agricultural Workforce and Extension Training Initiative is designed to make practical agricultural knowledge more accessible to beginning farmers, small-scale producers, farmworkers exploring agricultural entrepreneurship, immigrant and multilingual communities, and other underserved agricultural populations. Through bilingual, culturally responsive, and field-oriented education, planned activities include applied agronomy training; soil health and crop-management education; climate-smart and resilient practices; agricultural entrepreneurship and farm-management instruction; bilingual educational materials; workshops and demonstration-based learning; technical assistance; small-group consultations; train-the-trainer activities; and curriculum development and adaptation. AGRILEAD intends to begin initial implementation and stakeholder engagement activities in Southwest Florida, with particular attention to Immokalee and agricultural communities in Collier, Lee, and Hendry Counties. As activities are implemented and documented, AGRILEAD will seek to refine its curricula, delivery methods, and learning tools and develop a practical training model that may be adapted for other agricultural communities. These efforts remain planned and subject to resources, stakeholder engagement, and appropriate institutional arrangements.
