Purpose of the Initiative

The initiative is designed to complement existing institutional efforts by providing practical training materials, bilingual outreach support, field-informed technical assistance, curriculum support, implementation tools, and documentation systems that help translate agricultural knowledge into usable action.

Target Beneficiaries

- Beginning farmers and small-scale producers;
- Immigrant and multilingual producers;
- Hispanic, Haitian Creole-speaking, and French-speaking agricultural communities;
- Producer groups, cooperatives, and underserved rural communities.

Key Areas of Support

- Agricultural training and capacity building;
- Applied agronomy and soil/crop production support;
- Climate-smart agriculture education;
- Bilingual outreach and producer education;
- MEAL, documentation, planning, and implementation tools.

Geographic Focus

AGRILEAD's initial focus is Southwest Florida, with priority attention to Collier County, Lee County, Hendry County, and agricultural or underserved communities near Immokalee. This area will serve as an initial testing ground for a practical and transferable training model.

Potential Collaboration Opportunities

AGRILEAD is seeking discussions with Extension offices, agricultural universities, nonprofit organizations, farmworker organizations, community-based groups, small-farmer organizations, producer associations, and related agricultural stakeholders.

- Participant outreach and workshop hosting.

Partnership Approach

AGRILEAD's role is to complement, not replace, the work of universities, Cooperative Extension services, producer associations, cooperatives, nonprofits, and community-based institutions by adding practical training, culturally responsive engagement, and implementation support where needed.

Projected Outputs 2026-2029

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- 4 to 6 practical training module outlines and materials;
- 6 to 12 pilot workshops or learning sessions;

- 10 to 20 trainers, facilitators, or community leaders engaged;
- One practical replication toolkit for potential adaptation.
